CLASS 2

Kingdom Structure

Understanding The Divine Order Of The Kingdom Of Elohim

SECTION 1 - INTRODUCTION

1 Corinthians 14:40

“Let all things be done decently and in order.”

Teaching 2 reminded us that the Kingdom of Elohim is not merely a belief system, religious tradition, or spiritual experience. The Kingdom is the government of Elohim operating according to His divine order and authority.

Throughout this teaching, we learned that every kingdom contains essential components that work together to establish, preserve, and enforce the rule of the King. Without structure, there can be no order. Without order, Kingdom life becomes misunderstood.

We examined five foundational components of Kingdom structure: The King, The Law, The Citizens, The Territory, and The Authority. These components reveal how the Kingdom functions and how disciples are called to live under the rule of Elohim.

As we continue through this framework, may we remember that understanding Kingdom structure is not the goal. Alignment with Kingdom structure is.

Kingdom Principle

The Kingdom functions according to divine order established by the King.

SECTION 2 - THE KING

Exodus 15:18

“The LORD shall reign for ever and ever.”

Every kingdom begins with a king. Without a king, there is no authority. Without authority, there is no law. Without law, there is no kingdom. Scripture consistently reveals Elohim as the eternal King whose authority existed before creation and whose reign has no end.

Yeshua did not establish a separate kingdom. He reveals, teaches, administers, and establishes the Father’s rule among men. The Kingdom begins with understanding who rules.

Until the King is rightly understood, law will feel optional, authority will feel restrictive, and obedience will feel unnecessary. Once the King is recognized, everything else in the Kingdom aligns.

Key Kingdom Truths

- Elohim is the eternal King.
- The King is the source of all authority.
- The Kingdom exists because the King reigns.
- Alignment begins with submission to the King.

Kingdom Principle

Everything in the Kingdom flows from the authority of the King.

THE KING

When Scripture speaks of the Kingdom of Elohim, it first establishes who rules. A king is not symbolic, elected, advisory, or optional. A king rules by right.

From the Torah to the Psalms, through the Prophets, and into the testimony of Yeshua, the Bible consistently presents Elohim as the eternal reigning King whose authority is established and whose Kingdom has no end.

Who truly governs my life?

Where have I resisted the King's authority?

Do my decisions reflect allegiance to the King?

SECTION 3 - THE LAW

Deuteronomy 8:6

“Therefore thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, to walk in his ways, and to fear him.”

If the King is the source of authority, then the law is the expression of that authority. Law is not separate from the King. Law flows directly from Him and reveals how life functions within His Kingdom.

Torah means divine instruction. It reveals the King's will, His character, His order, and the way His citizens are called to live in covenant alignment.

The law does not compete with grace. It reveals the King's order and teaches redeemed people how to walk faithfully under His rule.

Key Kingdom Truths

- Law flows from the King.
- Torah reveals the King's character.
- Obedience preserves Kingdom order.
- The law teaches citizens how to walk with the King.

Kingdom Principle

The law is the revealed will of the King for His Kingdom citizens.

THE LAW

Torah is not about earning favor. It teaches redeemed people how to live in alignment with the Kingdom of Elohim.

The law was never the problem. Disobedience was. When the King is honored, His law is received as wisdom, order, and life-preserving instruction.

What areas of obedience have I delayed?

Where am I resisting the King's instruction?

SECTION 4 - THE CITIZENS

Exodus 19:5-6

“Ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation.”

A kingdom cannot exist without citizens. Citizens are not observers, attendees, or volunteers. Citizens are governed people who live under the authority of the King, obey His law, and represent His Kingdom.

Kingdom citizenship is not based upon ethnicity, background, title, or outward association. It is based upon allegiance to the King and obedience to His will.

True citizens hear the Word of Elohim and obey it. Relationship to the King is demonstrated through obedience, not proximity, title, or confession alone.

Key Kingdom Truths

- Citizens belong to the King.
- Citizenship requires allegiance.
- Obedience confirms Kingdom citizenship.
- Kingdom citizens represent the King.

Kingdom Principle

Citizenship is revealed through faithful obedience to the King.

THE CITIZENS

Citizenship in the Kingdom is not merely claimed. It is walked out through covenant faithfulness and obedience.

Yeshua makes it unmistakably clear that Kingdom citizenship is not determined by words, titles, or association, but by doing the will of the Father.

SECTION 4 - THE CITIZENS

Reflection, Conviction & Repentance

Does my life reflect Kingdom citizenship?

Am I living under the King's authority?

What evidence of allegiance is visible in my life?

SECTION 5 - THE TERRITORY

Genesis 1:26

“Let them have dominion... over all the earth.”

Territory is the domain of the King. It is the realm over which His authority is exercised and His rule is enforced. Heaven and earth are not independent realms. They belong to Elohim.

From the beginning, dominion was delegated by the King, not seized by creation. Humanity stewards territory under Him and by His authority.

Territory is not ownership apart from the King. It is stewardship under the King. The Kingdom expands wherever the King's will is obeyed.

Key Kingdom Truths

- The King owns all territory.
- Humanity stewards territory under the King.
- The Kingdom advances through obedience.
- There is no neutral ground.

Kingdom Principle

The Kingdom is manifested wherever the King's will is obeyed.

SECTION 5 - THE TERRITORY

Bible Foundations

- Genesis 1:26
- Psalm 115:16
- Daniel 2:44
- Matthew 6:10

These foundational Scriptures support and strengthen the Kingdom principles taught within this section.

THE TERRITORY

Territory is the domain of the King. It is not ownership apart from Him, but stewardship under His rule.

Where His rule is rejected, disorder remains. Where His will is submitted to, His Kingdom is made present.

SECTION 5 - THE TERRITORY

Reflection, Conviction & Repentance

Where is the King's rule evident in my life?

Am I stewarding what belongs to Elohim faithfully?

What territory remains unsundered?

SECTION 6 - THE AUTHORITY

Matthew 28:18

“All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.”

Authority is not assumed. Authority is delegated. It flows from the King and is entrusted to those who remain aligned under His rule. Authority is the lawful right to command, govern, and enforce the King's will.

Authority follows allegiance, order, and submission. It never precedes them. Only those who live under the King's rule can rightly exercise the King's authority.

Authority without submission leads to rebellion, and authority without law leads to chaos. Kingdom authority must always remain under the government of the King.

Key Kingdom Truths

- Authority is delegated by the King.
- Authority follows alignment.
- Authority must remain under law.
- Authority exists to serve the King's purposes.

Kingdom Principle

Only those submitted to the King's authority can rightly exercise Kingdom authority.

THE AUTHORITY

Authority is entrusted, not seized. It is exercised through submission to the King and obedience to His law.

Only those who live under the King's rule can rightly represent His authority. Authority flows after alignment, never before.

SECTION 6 - THE AUTHORITY

Reflection, Conviction & Repentance

Am I seeking authority before alignment?

Do I remain submitted to the King's rule?

Am I using influence for the King's purposes or my own?

KINGDOM ACTION STEPS

- Honor the King above all else.
- Submit daily to His authority.
- Study and obey His law.
- Live as a faithful Kingdom citizen.
- Steward every area entrusted to you.
- Walk in humility and submission.
- Pursue alignment before authority.
- Prepare your heart for Week 3: Covenant & Kingdom Identity.

Father, establish Your Kingdom order within me.
