CLASS 11

Spiritual Warfare & Kingdom Conflict

Recognizing Spiritual Opposition & Remaining Faithful to the Mission

SECTION 1 - INTRODUCTION

Ephesians 6:10-12

"Be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might."

"For we wrestle not against flesh and blood."

Teaching 11 reveals that spiritual warfare cannot be understood correctly if every person who opposes us is identified as the enemy. Scripture shows a deeper conflict: our ultimate struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against spiritual powers that resist Elohim's truth and Kingdom mission.

The teaching traces this conflict through the Torah, the Psalms, the Prophets, Yeshua, and the apostolic witness. The adversary deceives, tempts, and accuses, yet YAH Elohim remains enthroned. The conflict is real, but darkness never stands above the authority of the King.

We were also reminded that victory is not produced by human strength. Yeshua has triumphed over principalities and powers, and Kingdom citizens stand through submission to Elohim, dependence upon the Holy Spirit, and confidence in what Messiah has accomplished.

Elohim has provided truth, righteousness, the Gospel of peace, faith, salvation, His Word, and prayer so that believers can withstand opposition. This armor is not religious imagery; it describes how truth is believed, righteousness is lived, faith is exercised, and dependence is maintained.

As we work through this guide, may we remain spiritually alert without becoming spiritually consumed. Spiritual warfare must never distract us from loving people, proclaiming the Gospel, making disciples, serving, obeying, and faithfully continuing the assignment.

Kingdom Principle

Spiritual warfare is not a call to magnify darkness, but to remain submitted to Elohim, grounded in truth, and faithful to the mission.

SECTION 2 - IDENTIFYING THE TRUE CONFLICT

Ephesians 6:10-12

Spiritual warfare begins with correctly identifying the conflict. People may oppose, wound, or resist us, but Scripture reveals that our ultimate struggle is not against flesh and blood.

Spiritual discernment sees beyond the immediate human conflict without turning the person into the ultimate enemy.

Key Kingdom Truths

- The adversary is real, but YAH Elohim remains enthroned.
- The conflict centers upon truth, allegiance, and obedience.
- People are not the believer's ultimate enemy.
- We resist spiritual evil while continuing to love people.

Kingdom Principle

Kingdom citizens fight correctly when they discern the unseen conflict while obeying Yeshua's command to love people.

PEOPLE ARE NOT THE TRUE ENEMY

The adversary works through deception, accusation, and resistance, but believers must not reduce a spiritual conflict to human hostility. Correct identification protects both our discernment and our love.

- The adversary seeks to redirect allegiance away from Elohim.
- Human opposition can exist within a greater spiritual conflict.
- Discernment looks beyond the moment without condemning the person.
- The weapons of our warfare are not carnal.
- Prayer, forgiveness, and love remain part of faithful resistance.

Where have I mistaken a person for the true enemy?

How can I resist spiritual evil while still loving and praying for people?

What situation currently requires greater spiritual discernment?

SECTION 3 - DECEPTION, TEMPTATION & ACCUSATION

Genesis 3:1-5

The enemy seeks to move believers away from trusting Elohim, believing His Word, and walking faithfully beneath His government through deception, temptation, and accusation.

Truth stored within us becomes protection when another voice attempts to lead us away from what Elohim has spoken.

Key Kingdom Truths

- Deception distorts Elohim's Word and character.
- Temptation invites departure from obedience.
- Accusation uses condemnation to immobilize believers.
- Every voice must be tested by what Elohim has revealed.

Kingdom Principle

We resist deception, temptation, and accusation by remaining submitted to Elohim and anchored in His truth.

SECTION 3 - DECEPTION, TEMPTATION & ACCUSATION

Bible Foundations

TRUTH EXPOSES THE ENEMY'S STRATEGIES

Deception makes falsehood appear trustworthy, temptation pressures us to depart from obedience, and accusation tries to drive us away from Elohim. His Word exposes each strategy and keeps the mind anchored.

- Knowing what is written helps us recognize distortion.
- Truth must be understood, stored, applied, and obeyed.
- Temptation is resisted through submission and faithful obedience.
- Conviction calls us back to Elohim; accusation drives us away.
- Messiah's finished work answers condemnation and intimidation.

SECTION 3 - DECEPTION, TEMPTATION & ACCUSATION

Reflection, Conviction & Repentance

What distorted thought must I test against the Word of Elohim?

Where is temptation pressuring me to compromise obedience?

Am I responding to restoring conviction or condemning accusation?

SECTION 4 - VICTORY, AUTHORITY & SUBMISSION

Colossians 2:13-15

Spiritual victory belongs to Elohim and is revealed through Yeshua Messiah. Kingdom citizens do not rely upon human strength, formulas, or self-generated confidence.

We do not magnify ourselves in spiritual warfare. We magnify the One who holds all power and has triumphed over the enemy.

Key Kingdom Truths

- The battle belongs to YAH Elohim.
- Victory comes by His Spirit, not human might.
- Yeshua has authority over the power of the enemy.
- Submission to Elohim comes before resistance.

Kingdom Principle

Kingdom authority is exercised safely through genuine faith, humble submission, and dependence upon Elohim.

SUBMISSION COMES BEFORE RESISTANCE

The Name of Yeshua is not a formula to be used apart from relationship, faith, submission, and obedience. Biblical confidence is neither self-exaltation nor fear; it is confident dependence upon Elohim.

- YAH fights for His people and teaches them how to stand.
- Spiritual victory cannot be produced by human strength.
- Yeshua triumphed openly over principalities and powers.
- Delegated authority must remain beneath the will of Elohim.
- Resistance flows from submission, not independence.

Reflection, Conviction & Repentance

Where have I relied upon my own strength instead of the Holy Spirit?

Does my resistance flow from genuine submission to Elohim?

How does Yeshua's victory change the way I face spiritual opposition?

SECTION 5 - THE ARMOR OF ELOHIM & PRAYER

Ephesians 6:13-18

Elohim equips His people with what comes from Him so that they can withstand opposition and remain faithful. The armor describes a life grounded in truth, obedience, faith, and prayer.

The armor of Elohim is not merely something we describe. It is truth believed, righteousness lived, faith exercised, and prayer maintained.

Key Kingdom Truths

- Truth confronts deception.
- Righteousness protects a life from compromise.
- Faith quenches the fiery darts of the wicked.
- Prayer keeps warfare rooted in dependence upon Elohim.

Kingdom Principle

We stand by remaining clothed with what Elohim has provided and by praying continually in dependence upon His Spirit.

CLOTHED WITH WHAT ELOHIM PROVIDES

The armor originates in Elohim's own truth, righteousness, salvation, and power. Each piece calls the believer to remain grounded, obedient, mission-ready, and dependent upon Him throughout the conflict.

- Truth answers deception and secures the mind.
- Righteousness refuses compromise and rebellion.
- The Gospel of peace keeps our feet prepared for mission.
- Faith rests in Elohim's character when fiery darts come.
- Salvation guards identity; the Word exposes falsehood.
- Watchful prayer keeps the believer dependent and alert.

SECTION 5 - THE ARMOR OF ELOHIM & PRAYER

Reflection, Conviction & Repentance

Which part of Elohim's provision have I neglected to walk in consistently?

What fiery dart must be answered with faith in Elohim's character?

How can watchful prayer become more consistent in my daily life?

SECTION 6 - STAND FAITHFULLY & CONTINUE THE MISSION

Nehemiah 4:17-18

Spiritual warfare must remain connected to the larger purpose of the Kingdom. Opposition may resist the mission, but it must not cause believers to abandon what Elohim has entrusted.

Be watchful, but keep building. Recognize the opposition, pray, stand in truth, and continue the assignment.

Key Kingdom Truths

- Discernment recognizes opposition; fear magnifies it.
- Watchfulness keeps us prepared; obsession distracts us.
- Our identity begins with belonging to Elohim.
- Spiritual warfare does not change the mission.

Kingdom Principle

Faithful Kingdom citizens stand against opposition without allowing warfare to replace worship, obedience, love, or mission.

SECTION 6 - STAND FAITHFULLY & CONTINUE THE MISSION

WATCHFULNESS WITHOUT OBSESSION

The conflict itself can become a distraction if the enemy occupies more of our attention than Elohim and His assignment. Scripture calls us to remain alert, courageous, prayerful, and faithful to the work.

- Fear magnifies opposition until obedience appears impossible.
- Watchfulness keeps our eyes upon Elohim while recognizing the enemy.
- The builders in Nehemiah remained armed and continued working.
- The apostles answered threats with prayer for boldness.
- Our joy rests in belonging to Elohim, not in spiritual power.
- Keep proclaiming, discipling, serving, and obeying.

KINGDOM ACTION STEPS

- Begin each day submitted to Elohim and dependent upon the Holy Spirit.
- Store the Word within you and test every voice by what Elohim has revealed.
- Love people while discerning the spiritual opposition behind the conflict.
- Reject deception, temptation, and accusation with truth and obedience.
- Put on the whole armor of Elohim and remain watchful in prayer.
- Recognize opposition without allowing fear or obsession to magnify it.
- Keep proclaiming, discipling, serving, obeying, and continuing the assignment.

PRAYER OF TRANSFORMATION

Father, strengthen me in You and in the power of Your might.

Teach me to recognize the true nature of the conflict
without mistaking people for the enemy.

Expose deception, fortify my heart against temptation,
and answer accusation with the truth of Yeshua's victory.

Clothe me with truth, righteousness, peace, faith, salvation, and Your Word.

Keep me watchful in prayer, submitted to Your authority,
and dependent upon Your Holy Spirit.

May opposition never move me from obedience
or cause me to abandon the assignment You have entrusted.

Let me stand in power, walk in authority,
and advance from the victory of Yeshua Messiah.

May you remain grounded in truth, clothed with what Elohim has provided, and
faithful to the mission when resistance comes.
